

**NOTICE FOR LOA APPLICANTS AND EXISTING LOA LICENSEES
CONCERNING BREXIT
FOR PURPOSES OF REACH REGISTRATION AND AUTHORIZATION**

March 14, 2019

The United Kingdom ('UK') has announced that after its potential withdrawal from the EU on March 29, 2019 or some time thereafter, the country will be setting up its own "REACH-like" chemicals registration / authorization system under which UK manufacturers / UK importers will have to register / apply for authorization.

The scope of the letters of access ('LoA(s)') on this website that have been issued by the REACH registration / authorization consortia has in the past been limited to the European Union's ('EU') REACH system. They could not be used for any other purpose.

Jones Day has worked with its REACH registration / authorization consortia over the past several weeks to proceed to amendments of the respective consortia agreements and third party data licensing agreements to come to an agreement that the existing LoAs shall also be valid for UK chemicals registration / authorization without extra cost. Some of these amendments and/or third party licensing negotiations are still on-going. We will therefore update this notice at the given time.

If an existing LoA licensee wishes to file a UK chemicals registration / authorization, he should fill in the template overleaf (one template per consortium) and send it to amccabe@jonesday.com. New LoA applicants should continue to use the existing LoA application form but mark separately the legal entities that wish to register / authorize in the UK.

The consortia will not issue letters of access for the United Kingdom only. Any new LoA applicants will have to purchase the existing REACH LoA.

We hereby acknowledge that the consortium shall not be obliged to update / amend its REACH registration or authorization dossiers for purposes of UK registration / authorization. UK registrants / authorization applicants shall be solely responsible for compliance with their UK regulatory requirements.

Important notes:

- (1) The UK legal entity must be an entity that is affiliated with the existing LoA licensee or must be an Only Representative appointed by the existing LoA licensee or its affiliated companies for purposes of UK chemicals registration / authorization.*
- (2) In the case of Only Representatives, please provide a copy of the Only Representative appointment with this notification.*
- (3) As regards styrene and ethylbenzene, affiliated companies are not within the scope of the original LoA. Therefore in these two cases, each existing LoA licensee can name one affiliated company in the UK or one Only Representative (representing one non-UK manufacturer). For any additional legal entity, a separate LoA must be purchased.*

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
